1. CALPERS COMPLETES DIVESTMENT FROM COAL

After a moving report and nearly 700 letters to the board, CalPERS finally finished divesting from selected thermal coal companies as required in a 2015 law.

2. BOARD MEMBERS SUPPORT DIVESTMENT

This year Tony Thurmond of CalSTRS and Margaret Brown of CalPERS announced support for divestment. In addition, CalPERS' board will review a report on fossil fuel stranded assets in early 2022.

3. TEACHERS ORGANIZE FOR DIVESTMENT

In 2021, eight teachers' unions passed divestment resolutions. In addition, teachers formed two organization to advocate for divestment within their unions.

2022 GOALS

As divestments sweep the country, it is entirely possible that 2022 becomes the year Californian pensions divest. Help us achieve divestment this year by volunteering or donating today.

1. CALIFORNIA TEACHERS ASSOCIATION SUPPORTS DIVESTMENT

In part due to false information, the CTA opposes divestment. However, teachers within CTA are organizing in support of divestment. FFCA is supporting CTA Divest's efforts and hopes to see the union's position flip in early 2022.

2. CALPERS OPENS PUBLIC DISCUSSION OF DIVESTMENT

In November, CalPERS Investment Board chair Theresa Taylor requested a report on fossil fuel stranded assets in the pension. FFCA is working with unions to escalate from report to open discussion of divestment by the CalPERS board in 2022.



3. DIVESTMENT LEGISLATION

We are working with a growing coalition to introduce fossil fuel divestment legislation to the California legislature in 2022. Legislation would mandate that pensions divest from fossil fuels, beginning immediately.

4. SUPPORT FOSSIL FUEL DRILLING PHASE OUT

We are expanding our campaigns! The Collaborating for Climate Justice team will be supporting campaigns such as 3200ft setbacks of drilling from communities run by allied organizations.
